IN HONOUR OF GARY PLAYER

ROUND 3 | SATURDAY 06-12-2025



Norway's Kristoffer Reitan will take a one-stroke lead into the weekend of the Nedbank Golf Challenge in honour of Gary Player, with Christiaan Bezuidenhout leading the South African challenge just three strokes behind him.



eitan signed for a 69 on Friday that was more of a battle compared with his opening 63, and he leads this field on 12 under par overall.

"I'm pretty happy. I struggled with the approach shots, but my short game saved me a few times," said Reitan. His nearest challenger is Frenchman Adrien Saddier, whose round elicited comments of "outrageous" from the commentators on more than one occasion as he produced sublime bunker shots on his way to a 67 and a total of 11 under par.

And Bezuidenhout produced a 65 to lead the South African challenge in joint third place on nine under par alongside France's Julien Guerrier.

Reitan again started strong with a birdie at the first, but he wasn't able to unlock all of the secrets of this Gary Player Country Club course as he stumbled with backto-back bogeys on 15 and 16 before finishing with a birdie on 18.

"It's a tough course and I'm happy to finish strong with a birdie at the last. It's difficult to stay patient out there. The wind goes in circles here so I had no idea what I was doing. It feels like it could be in any direction and that's not a huge confidence boost when you're standing over the golf ball. But I felt like I dealt with it as best as I could," he said.

Behind him, Saddier made an equally fast start with an eagle on the par-five second after a magnificent bunker shot to within six feet of the hole. He birdied the third to keep his charge going. But the closing holes were also a challenge for him as he bogeyed two of the last three. In the midst of that was another terrific bunker shot on 17 to save par there.

"It was a pretty hot start which is good on this course. It's a pity about the finish. The second on 17 was quite lucky because I didn't expect to reach the green to be honest. It came off hot off the face, so it was lucky but I'll take it. My long game is pretty solid and I just need to keep going for the next two days."





## Bezuidenhout has another shot at glory

hristiaan Bezuidenhout has another shot at a victory he has dreamt of since he was a boy.
Bezuidenhout has given himself another chance to win "Africa's Major" after finishing fifth in 2022 and sixth in 2024.

And it means the world to him to be in the hunt going into the weekend in a tournament every South African golfer has grown up watching and wanting to win.

"It's always been a tournament that I've wanted to win. I've been coming here since I was a young kid watching Ernie Els and all the greats play here. I've come close before and now I've put myself in a good position again. Hopefully I can get over the line," said Bezuidenhout as he starts the third round just three shots off the lead. He has enjoyed a victory on this Gary Player Country Club course before in the 2020 South African Open, so he knows the golf course better than most.

"The key for me out here is to keep it in play off the tee, so I've put a lot of emphasis on my drives to keep them in play. The golf course has a few changes since my win here five years ago, but from tee to green it plays pretty much the same.

"This is not like any parkland course where you can miss the fairway and still get to the green. If you miss a fairway here it's a lost ball."









he Nedbank Golf Challenge is a massive logistical operation on all fronts, and none more so than when it comes to the catering.

Feeding the thousands of guests over four intensive days of golf is a feat worthy of being declared a Major all on its own.

"It's a massive task for us considering the logistics. All in all we're looking after about 40 different marquee set-ups across the tournament. But the teams we have are so dedicated team and they do a phenomenal job," says Casper Niewoudt, the Food and Beverage Services Manager.

"The planning actually starts in February. We begin with feedback from our sponsors, then we redesign the menus for the current year, go through our recipes, look at the budgets with our partners, and then we begin planning the logistics in terms of vehicles as well as the building of five kitchens on the course fully kitted out

with ovens, because food safety is extremely important for us. So we maintain our cold chains as well." And it's a team effort that also includes the local community.


"We involve our local community and have over 450 individuals who work the tournament with us for a two-week period of preparation and then during the tournament. We also bring in visiting supporting chefs for exposure and experience. Everybody works towards the same goal of executing a successful event."

Anybody who has attended a Nedbank Golf Challenge will know all about two of the biggest food favourites – the ribs and the ice cream.

"The ribs and ice cream have always been a favourite. We go through about 100 000 ice creams over the tournament, and we bring in about 16.5 tonnes of protein because South Africans love their meat."

"Africa's Major" is indeed a feast in all respects.
